## ADVOCACY



Development and release of the MB Agriculture **Trade Action Plan**, with recommendations for Manitoba's trade success

- Secured seat on Manitoba's U.S. Trade Council to advise province on CUSMA priorities for agriculture
- **Permanent 10% reduction on fuel tax**
- **Disaster Financial Assistance**
  - Ownership requirement removed
  - Max yearly gross revenue ↑ to \$15M
  - Compensation cap ↑ to \$3M
